Commercial Motor Vehicle – In-Vehicle Assessment

PURPOSE

- To assess the in-vehicle driving performance of personnel;
- To elevate a Driver's awareness of the driving-related tasks through Assessor's feedback;
- To assist in developing an ongoing driver improvement program.

PROCEDURE

The assessor will carry out a one-on-one evaluation in a variety of road environments and conditions, focusing specifically on the skills, knowledge and attitudes manifest throughout. Based on these primary observations, the Assessor will coach the Driver in critical performance areas. Both strengths and weaknesses will be highlighted through in-vehicle coaching, and later summarized in written form. It should again be emphasized that this program is fundamentally developmental in its aims; in no way is it a disciplinary or punitive measure.

DAILY SCHEDULE Assessments would be performed according to the following schedule. Schedule allows for driver ½ full day or 2 drivers ½ day each.
